Dear 3K & Pre-K Parent(s),

Welcome to 3K & Pre-K! We are looking forward to meeting all of you soon! In order to get our year started smoothly, the following is a list of school supplies your child will need to begin the school year. This year the priorities for some supplies are higher than others. Please send them to school with your child.

Please have all supplies in by September 30, 2024

- A small blanket or a sheet for rest time (small pillows are optional). The blanket or sheet will be sent home for laundry every Friday.
- A labeled cloth bag for storing rest time items
- Two complete change of clothes including underwear, socks, and a sweater (all labeled with child's name on it)
- A small soft doll (stuffed animal etc.) for rest time (if necessary). Please do not send other toys and or toy jewelry from home.
- 2 pocket folders (preferably vinyl)
- 1 box of gallon zip locks bags
- 1 box of quart size zip lock bags
- 3 packs of unscented baby wipes
- 20-30 Pull-Ups in labeled bag (3K Only)

- 1 package of dry erase markers
- 3 bottles of antibacterial liquid hand soap
- 4 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 3 packages of disinfectant wipes
- 3 reams of white copy paper
- 1 box of Crayola washable markers
- 3 boxes of Kleenex/facial tissues
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (medium or large)
- 3 boxes of colored pencils
- 2 packs of sharpened #2 pencils (2 boxes of 24)
- Family photos and an individual portrait photo of your child by 9/27

Suggested Supply List to Keep at Home:

- 1 pack of Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pack of drawing paper
- 1 box of Crayola washable markers
- 1 pair of headphones (optional)
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (medium or large)

- 1 pair of safety scissors
- 1 pack of construction paper
- 1 dry erase whiteboard
- 1 set of teddy counters (math manipulative)
- 1 Play-doh
- 1 set of linking cubes
